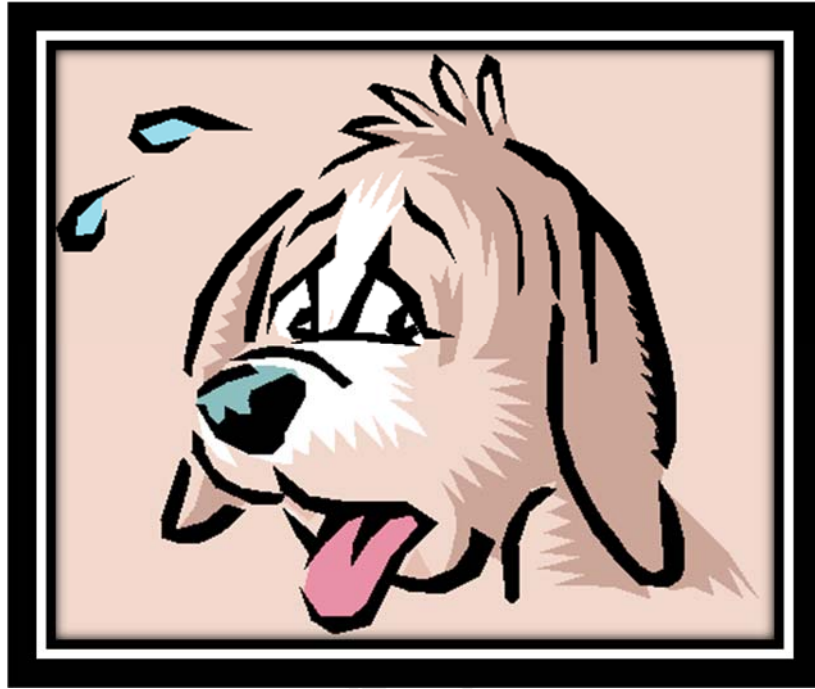


JULY is NATIONAL PET HYDRATION MONTH
